CITEIS OF VESUVIUS: POMPEII AND HERCULANEUM

The GLADIATORIAL GAMES

- A popular form of entertainment in Pompeii was the gladiatorial games.
- > Held in the amphitheater, or in the initial stages of the Samnite era, in the open courtyard of the Forum.
- Archaeological remains are held in the Museum of Naples. Excavated in 1776-67. Helmets, greaves and weapons. Very well preserved with embossed decorations of very skilled craftsmen
- It is generally accepted that the Gladiators of Pompeii enjoyed some stardom. Many women left inscriptions for their favourites all over the amphitheater grounds...

"Thracian Celadus is the heart throb of the girls."

– Gladiator Barracks

"(Marcus Cantrius Marcellus, son of Marcus, duumvir, instead of games and lights, saw the construction of three seating sectors, by the decree of the town councillors."

-Amphitheatre

"20 pairs of gladiators of Gnaeus Alleius Nigidius Maius, quinquennial, and their substitutes will fight without any public expense" – House of Trebius Valens

The PALAESTRA

- As an exercise yard, it sat adjacent to the amphitheatre. The open area was for various uses, not just practising with sword and spear, but for general fitness too.
- > Not restricted to the gladiators, the public could come and use the space to exercise with their champions.
- Solution Solution
- The Palaestra was a portico structure. Columns surrounding the open space. It seems the barracks were around the outside with resident rooms available for the gladiators.





The Amphitheatre

- > The blood sports! Number vary from 15,000 to 20,000 spectators.
- There are plenty of wall paintings, inscriptions, reliefs and mosaics describing what happened in the games.
- Soxing, gladiator combat, wild beast shows vs gladiators or vs wild beasts
- The barracks was attached next door and 60 skeletons were found, including a woman wearing very expensive jewellery
- One helmet found in Herculaneum but no amphitheatre has been found.















